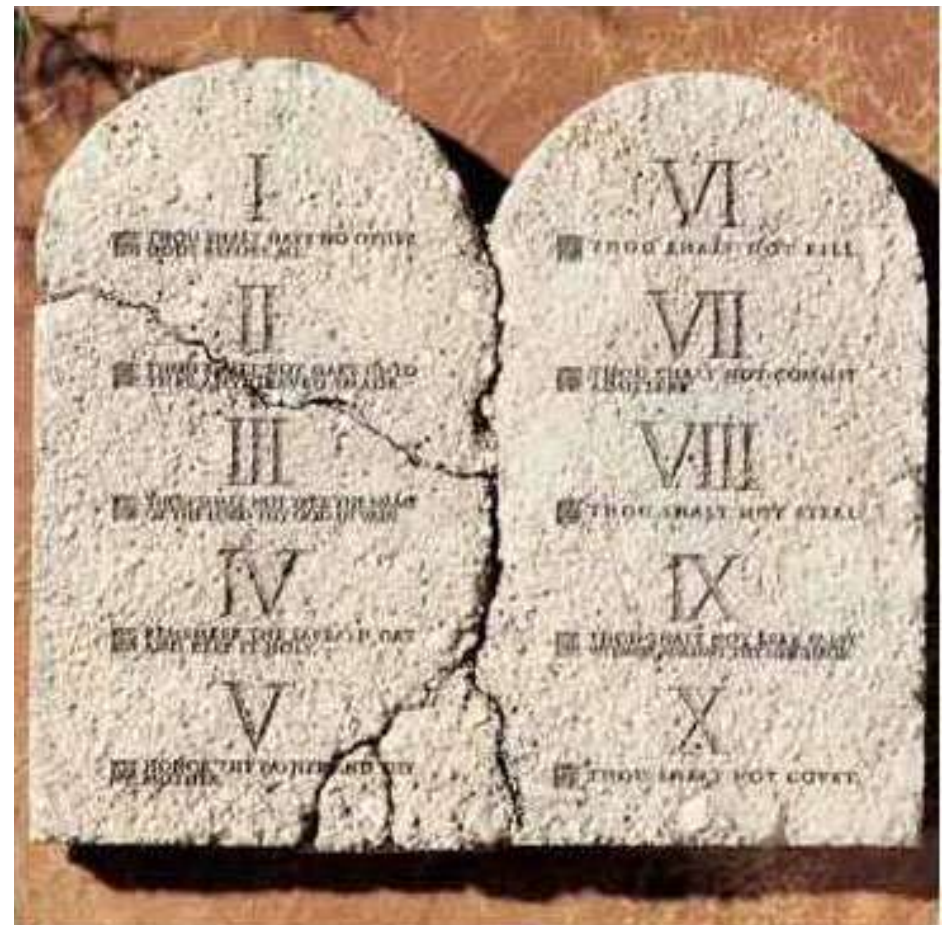


# The Ten Commandments



# Are the Ten Commandments binding today?

- **Ex. 20:1-17** – The Ten Commandments
  1. Do not place other gods before Jehovah **-Acts 17:24-29**
  2. Do not worship idols **-I Cor. 8:4-6**
  3. Do not take Jehovah's name in vain **-Matt. 6:9**
  4. Remember the Sabbath **-???**
  5. Honor father and mother **-Eph. 6:1-3**
  6. Do not murder **-I Jn. 3:15**
  7. Do not commit adultery **-I Cor. 6:9**
  8. Do not steal **-I Pet. 4:15**
  9. Do not bear false witness **-Rev. 21:8**
  10. Do not covet **-Heb. 13:5**

# Are the Ten Commandments binding today?

- What about remembering the Sabbath Day?
  - **Heb. 7:12** – The Law has changed
  - The First day of the week, Lord's Day (Rev. 1:10) is now the day that is set apart
    - **Acts 20:7, I Cor. 16:1-2** (Jesus was raised on a Sunday, the church was established on a Sunday)
    - It is not so much the day itself that is holy, but what is to happen on this day – the Lord's Supper – **Acts 20:7, I Cor. 11**
