Predestination - What does man teach?

- **God elects individual people to salvation**
 - **Man does not have any free will in the matter of salvation**
- **The elect of God cannot fall or be lost, and the lost cannot do anything to achieve salvation**

Predestination – Scripture

- **Rom. 8:29-30**
 - **Context is dual nature of man (body, soul)**
 - **Why have love? v.28**
 - **God predetermined that those who wish to be saved must be conformed to the image of his son, v.29**
 - **God then called through the Gospel those who would have the required character, v.28, 30...Note they were NOT justified BEFORE they were called... had to answer the call**

Predestination – Scripture

- **Eph. 1:4-6, 11**
 - **Character of people "chosen" to be in His Kingdom must be holy and without blame, v.4 (The Church– 5:27)**
 - **Those who submit to this predefined character and obey are adopted as sons, v.5 (Rom. 8:29)**
 - **The “inheritance” was predestined, v.11**
 - **What is required of those who seek the inheritance? v.12-14**

Predestination – Scripture

- **I Pet. 1:2**
 - **Context = greatness of inheritance v.3-4, 10**
 - **Elect were "chosen" because, in the foreknowledge of God, salvation had already been planned, v.2**
 - **Plan includes the sprinkling of the blood of Jesus on those who would be sanctified, v.2.**
 - **The obedience of these individuals sets them apart (sanctifies), v.2, Acts 22:16, Rom. 6:4-6, Heb. 10:22**

Predestinación-¿qué dice la Biblia enseña?

- **Luke 19:10** – Jesus came to seek and save the lost, not the predestined
- **I Tim. 2:4** – God desires all men to be saved
- **John 3:16-17; II Pet. 3:9** – God doesn't want any to perish
- **II Pet. 1:10** – Individuals must make their calling and election sure (stable, solid) = possibility of failure

Predestination – What does man teach?

- God elects individual people to salvation
– Man does not have any free will in the matter of salvation
- The elect of God **cannot fall** or be lost, and the **lost cannot** do anything to achieve salvation
- The Bible is clear that man has free will, the **elect can fall**, and the **lost can be saved...** why do many believe this?
- “Fear, uncertainty”, etc. - **live how they want**
