- **Saved God's people alive from famine –**  
*Gen. 45:7, 50:20*  
– *Joseph had faith in God's providence*
- **Saved God's people from Persian destruction –**  
*Esther 4:7-8, 14*  
– *Mordecai had faith in God's providence*
- **Saved Paul to bear witness in Rome –**  
*Acts 23:11-24, 27:23-26, 39-44*  
– *Paul trusted in God's providence*

## Seeing God bring about Good

- Whether happy or unhappy events come, good can always come from them: (*“seeing isn’t believing, believing is seeing”*)
  - Rom. 8:28
  - Phil. 1:12-14, James 1:2-3

God’s Providence – *The use of God’s non-miraculous power to ensure the care and growth of His people, despite physically happy or unhappy circumstances that may occur.*
