V. 1:

- I am blessed, no matter what happens
– Psm. 23:1-4; Isa. 26:1-4; Phil. 4:11-13
- Prayer is essential to remembering I am blessed – Phil. 4:6-8; I Pet. 5:7

V. 2:

- **I will face trials from the wicked one...**
 - Eph. 6:11-13, 16; Jas. 1:2-4, 12
- **...but God will not allow me to be tempted beyond what I am able to bear**
 - 1 Cor. 10:13
- **Jesus was willing to die for me – I must live for Him – Rom. 5:6-8**

Is it well with my soul? (#626)

V. 3:

- Oh, the bliss of knowing what Jesus did for me! – Eph. 2:1-7, 11-13, 19
- This wonderful peace is achieved by the blood of Jesus through baptism – Col. 1:19-23; 2:11-14
- Nothing else and no one else could do what Jesus did – Heb. 9:11-12; 10:1-10

V. 4:

- **Right now, I walk by faith, not sight – II Cor. 5:6-7**
- **One Day, faith will BE sight – I Cor. 15:51-52; I Thess. 4:13-18**

Conclusion:

- **Am I able to say, “It is well with my soul”?** – **II Tim. 1:12; 4:6-8**
- **Can I “hasten” the coming of the Day of the Lord?** – **II Pet. 3:11-12, 14; Rev. 22:12-14, 20**
