<u>Spirituality</u> – belief in ideas of religious significance, such as God, Heaven, etc

<u>Organized Religion</u> – the structure and creeds of a specific religion or faith; i.e. Baptist, Catholic

- How do we please God?
 –Doing good and sharing Heb. 13:16
 - -By rejecting sinful nature Rom. 8:8
 - -Having faith Heb. 11:6

-Following the apostle's commands -I Thess. 4:1-2

- Following the commandment:
 - -Baptism is the means of entering into the church, making it an act of "organized religion" – Acts 2:38-39, 41, 47
 - -The church is the body Col. 1:18, 24
 - -Baptism is the means of entering into the Body of Christ - Rom. 6:3, Gal. 3:27, I Cor. 12:13
 - -Baptism is the means of entering into the Kingdom of Heaven - John 3:5

- Is organized religion found in the NT? -Yes!
 - <u>Matt. 16:18;</u> Acts 13:1; 14:23; I Cor. 11:18; <u>I Cor. 14:33, 40;</u> Col. 4:16; Rev. 2 & 3
- Is spirituality found separate from organized religion?
 –No!
 - Acts 2:41, 47; 10:1-4, 48; 19:1, 4-5

- So what do I have to do to please God?

 Pleasing God means following the apostle's commands I Thess. 4:1-2
 - The apostles taught the same thing in every church I Cor. 4:17
 - The church is the pillar and ground of the truth I Tim. 3:15
 - -Jesus told the apostles to tell us <u>what</u> <u>to do</u> - Matt. 28:18-20
