

What is an unconditional inevitability?

Inevitable: *“unable to be avoided, evaded, or escaped; certain; necessary; sure to occur, happen, or come; unalterable”*

Unconditional: *“not limited by conditions; absolute”*

Five Unconditional Inevitabilities

- **Death will come one day – Heb. 9:27**
 - **I Cor. 15:20-22** – Because of Adam, all die
 - **Eccl. 3:2; 9:5; 12:7** – Death is a natural part of physical life
 - **Only one exception:**
 - **Those who are alive when Christ returns**
 - **I Thess. 4:13-17**

Five Unconditional Inevitabilities

- **Christ will return – Jn. 14:1-3**
 - **Acts 1:9-11** – He will return as He left
 - **I Thess. 5:2** – He will come at a time when no one expects
 - **Will He go back to Jerusalem? He won't even set foot back on earth! – I Thess. 4:16-17**

Five Unconditional Inevitabilities

- **There will be a resurrection of the dead –**
Acts 24:15
 - **I Cor. 15:20-23** – Jesus paved the way
 - **Is the resurrection already past?**
Hymenaeus and Philetus taught this, but if this is the case, what is the point of living faithfully? II Tim. 2:16-18
 - **Jn. 5:28-29** – While all will be raised, not all will be raised unto salvation
 - **Where will our soul end up??**
