

What is an unconditional inevitability?

Inevitable: *“unable to be avoided, evaded, or escaped; certain; necessary; sure to occur, happen, or come; unalterable”*

Unconditional: *“not limited by conditions; absolute”*

Five Unconditional Inevitabilities

- **The world will be destroyed –II Pet. 3:10-13**
 - II Cor. 4:18** – The things that are seen are temporary
 - What about 1,000 reign on earth?**
 - **From Rev. 20** – says nothing of God remaking the physical world
 - Rev. 21** John sees a new heaven and new earth, but we know this to be spiritual – **I Cor. 15:50ff**

Five Unconditional Inevitabilities

- **There will be a judgment – II Cor. 5:10**
 - **Heb. 9:27** – After death comes the judgment
 - **II Tim. 4:1** – Christ will judge the living and the dead
 - **Rev. 20:11-15** – The judgment scene
 - **How can we be sure that this will take place? How do we know that God won't just save everyone? Acts 17:30-31, Matt. 7:21ff**

 - **Through baptism – I Pet. 3:20-21**
 - **Through continued obedience – I Cor. 15:2;
