

**What must I say/do
to be saved?**

**What must I know
to be saved?**

- 1) *To perceive or understand as fact or truth; to apprehend clearly and with certainty*
- 2) *To have established or fixed in the mind or memory*

What must I know to be saved?

- Know that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God – Acts 8:37; Matt. 16:16; John 20:31
 - This fact is made clear throughout the New Testament – Matt. 16:16; John 6:69; John 11:27; Acts 9:20; Rom. 1:3; I Cor. 1:9; 2 Cor. 1:19; Heb. 5:5; I John 1:3, 7; 2:22; 3:23; 5:20; 2 John 1:3
- Even the demons know this – Luke 4:41

What must I know to be saved?

- Know that baptism saves me by washing away my sins – I Pet. 3:21; Acts 22:16; 2:38, 41
 - This fact is made clear throughout the New Testament – Mark 16:16; Acts 8:12-13, 36-38; Matt. 28:19; Acts 9:18; 10:47-48; 16:15, 33; 18:8; 19:5; Rom. 6:3; I Cor. 12:13; Gal. 3:27; Col. 3:12; Eph. 4:5
- Is essential to be saved – Eph. 4:4-6

What must I know to be saved?

- Know that as I am baptized, the Lord adds me to the body of Christ, which is the church, which has subjected itself to God's rule – Acts 2:38, 41; 8:12; 28:31; Col. 1:18, 24, 13-14; Rom. 14:17
- The need to be in the Kingdom is clear in the New Testament – Eph. 5:5; Gal. 5:21; I Cor. 15:50; 6:9-10; Acts 19:8; 14:22;
- Jesus Himself tells us the means by which we enter the Kingdom – John 3:3-5

What must I know to be saved?

- Know that you must be “born again” – I Pet. 1:3, 23; (3:21), (John 3:3)

- Will you be born again today? I Pet. 4:1-3
