How can I be a “son of encouragement”?

- **By being generous – Acts 4:32-37**
 - **Rom. 12:13 – We are to be given to hospitality**
 - **I Pet. 4:8-9 – We are to be generous without grudging**
 - **I Tim. 6:17-19 – Our hospitality will provide a foundation for the time to come**
 - **What can I do to help my brother in need?**

How can I be a “son of encouragement”?

- By welcoming a brother/sister— Acts 9:26-30
 - I Pet. 5:14 – Greet with a kiss of love
 - Phil. 4:21 – Greet every saint in Christ Jesus

How can I be a “son of encouragement”?

- By teaching and service – Acts 11:19-30
 - Barnabas taught, sought Paul, and carried funds – He was considering the brethren
 - I Cor. 9:19-23 – Paul made himself a servant by teaching all men concerning Christ
 - Gal. 5:13 – We are to serve one another
 - What can I say or do that will help my brother/sister in their service to God?

How can I be a “son of encouragement”?

- **By considering the spiritual or emotional needs of my brother/sister – Acts 15:36-41**
 - **John Mark needed another chance**
 - **He left the work before – Acts 13:13**
 - **Because of this chance, he was once again profitable to the work – II Tim. 4:11**
 - **Gal. 6:2 – We are to bear one another’s burdens – How can I help carry a burden?**
