# Why does God allow bad things to happen to innocent people?

## III. Answers: Actions of others

1. **God will not interfere with the free will of man to choose right or wrong, good or evil**  
– **Lev. 26, (I Tim. 2:3-4, Acts 17:30, II Pet. 3:9, Ezek. 33:11); Gen. 50:20**
  - A. **Therefore the innocent will always suffer for the choices, and often the consequences, of those who do evil**
  - B. **What would we have God do? Stop people from doing anything bad, ever?**

# Why does God allow bad things to happen to innocent people?

## II. Answers: Natural Causes

2. God alone is wise – He allows situations to happen, not for evil but for good – But we must remain faithful through the temptations that may come from the situations in which we find ourselves – **Jas. 1:13, 17, I Cor. 10:13, Job 42:1-6, 10-11**
- A. What would we have God do? Not ever let anyone get sick? Not ever let anything bad happen? **Rev. 21:3-5**
