Modern def — "a person or thing regarded with blind admiration, adoration, or devotion"

Vine's def – "a phantom or likeness; vain thing" (Acts 14:15)

- No other "gods" are to be worshipped aside from Jehovah
 - -Lev. 26:1, Ex. 20:4 No graven images
 - -Acts 12:22, 14:11, 28:6 No man
 - -Acts 14:14-18 Neither have any power
 - -Be aware of those that are misguided:
 - Worship other "gods" Ex. Buddha
 - Placing false characteristics on Jehovah Ex. Allah
 - Exalting men as "gods" Ex. Pope

- Idols are not limited to graven images or men
 - -Another definition for "idol": "any image, person, item, or concept that takes up such attention and/or devotion as to distract a person from the service of God"
 - This can apply to work, school, possessions, etc
 - -Col. 3:5 Covetousness is idolatry
 - Ex. 18:21 We should hate covetousness
 - Luke 12:15 Life does not consist of
 - I Tim. 6:9-10 Many fall because of

- Sources of idolatry
 - -Covetousness
 - Lack of focus
 - -Psm. 119:36 Be inclined to God's word
 - -Ezek. 33:31 Can be a symptom of a double heart
 - -Heb. 13:5 Requires contentment
 - -Idols
 - Desire to see, touch, make personal, one's god
 - -Acts 14:11-13, Acts 17:22-29
