

Lessons from Haggai

- **Haggai 1:1-11** – The people were seeing to their own homes, neglected the Lord's house
- **We can not put more importance on this life than serving in the work of the Lord - II Tim. 2:3-4; see Rev. 3:14-20**

Lessons from Haggai

- **Haggai 2:10-14** – The people were defiled, and their work
- **No amount of “holy” work will be accepted by the Lord if our motivation is not correct**
– **Rev. 2:1-5; I Sam. 15:22; Mark 12:33**

Lessons from Haggai

- **Haggai 2:1-9** – God says He will establish a “greater”, “better” temple than the one the people neglected
- **If God placed that much importance on His house then, how much more so now?**
Heb. 8:7-10; Heb. 3:1-6; I Pet. 2:4-7

Lessons from Haggai

- **Haggai 2:6-7, 9, 20-23; Heb. 12:25-29 – God will bring about what He has promised**
- **This should provide motivation for us to obey, as it did for the people of Israel – Haggai 1:12-15**
