Lessons from King Neb: Dan. 4

- **The Lesson that King Nebuchadnezzar was to learn: [Dan. 4:28-33](#)**
 - **The Most High rules in the kingdom of men**
 - **“Most High” – ‘illay = “supreme ruler”**
 - **“rules” – shalliyt = “oversees mightily”**
 - **“kingdom” – malku’ = “dominion, realm”**
 - **He gives it to whomever He chooses**

Lessons from King Neb: Dan. 4

- **Lessons - Applications**
 - **Rom. 13:1-7** – God continues to oversee the kingdom of men – God is aware of all
 - God continues to give it to whomever He chooses
 - **Prov. 21:1** – Does not mean that God chooses the individual – God uses those in authority to bring about His will
 - **I Tim. 2:1-4** – Prayers should be offered on their behalf

Lessons from King Neb: Dan. 4

- **The Lesson that King Nebuchadnezzar learned: **Dan. 4:1-3, 34-37****
 - **God’s works are “truth”**
 - “truth” only used two times in OT – Dan. 2:47 – lit. “fidelity”, faithfulness
 - **God’s ways (*conduct*) are justice (*lit. judgment*)**
 - **God puts down (*Dan. 5:22-humbles*) those who walk in pride**

Lessons from King Neb: Dan. 4

- **Lessons - Applications**

- **I Cor. 10:13, II Thess. 3:3; I John 1:9; Heb. 11:11, 10:23 – God is faithful**

- **John 5:22, 27, 30; Rom. 10:1-4 – God's ways establish the standard of judgment**

- **Matt. 23:12; Jas. 4:6-10 – God has always, and will always, humble the proud**

Lessons from King Neb: Dan. 4

- **Conclusion – What was King Nebuchadnezzar to do? Dan. 4:18-27**
 - **Stop sinning by turning to righteousness**
 - **Do works worthy of repentance (Luke 3:8)**
