Humble, Gentle, and Meek

I. Defining terms

- A. **Humble** – the state of not being puffed up with pride, thinking one is better than others
- B. **Gentle** – the application of humility in how one conducts themselves with others
- C. **Meek** – the soundness of mind to control one's actions and words, even when faced with provocative actions from others

How can we stay humble, gentle, and meek?

- 1. Pray! Remember that we are subject to the Will of God**
 - A. Picture yourself bowing before the throne of the Almighty God – Rev. 4:1-6**
- 2. Practice what you preach! Remember that we too will be judged**
 - A. We must be careful to maintain our high standard of conduct lest we be disqualified – I Cor. 9:24-27**

How can we stay humble, gentle, and meek?

3. Look for ways to be a servant! Remember that even Jesus came to serve, not to be served.

A. Jesus left Heaven for us – Phil. 2:5-8

B. The servant must always be humble, gentle, and meek...just like Jesus – James 3:13, 16-17
