- God desires sincere obedience
  - -I Sam. 15:22 God wants obedience before all else
  - **Deut. 26:16** Source of obedience should be from the heart

- God desires sincere obedience
  - -Love is a motivating factor to provide the "want to"
    - Deut. 5:10, Deut. 10:12-16 Love God and keep His commandments
    - Jn. 14:15, I Jn. 5:2-3 If we love Christ we will keep commands
    - Psm. 119:47-48, 127-131 Love the work, love being obedient (worship,etc.)

- How do we apply this...
  - -...in everyday life? Jas. 1:22
    - Prayer/Praise
      - -Pray sincerely, not just routine (food, etc)
    - Being an example to others
      - -Inviting people to church because we care
      - -Others need to see someone who loves living as a Christian no apologies!

- How do we apply this...
  - -...in everyday life? Jas. 1:22
    - Contact with brethren:
      - -Who have fallen away, Jas. 5:19-20
      - -Who are struggling with issues
      - -To spend time together, get to know one another
    - Let brethren encourage us!

- How do we apply this...
  - -...in worship? John 4:24
    - Prayer
      - -Concentrate on the words being said
    - Singing
      - -Words first, notes second
    - Lord's Supper
      - -Thoughts of Christ, His death, what He did for us

- How do we apply this...
  - -...in worship? John 4:24
    - Contribution
      - -Joy in knowing that we are helping the work of the Lord
    - Studying God's word (sermon, class)
      - -Minds devoted to learning and applying

- Our goal:
  - -Be motivated to live faithfully as a Christian
  - -Be "zealous for good works"
  - -Have joy when you are doing what you are supposed to be doing and do it because you love God
