# Preparing our minds for the Lord's Supper

Why do we partake?

Jesus instituted it –  
Luke 22:14-20

To proclaim the Lord's  
death until He comes –  
I Cor. 11:20-26

We have  
approved  
example –  
Acts 2:42

“This do in  
remembrance of Me”

# Preparing our minds for the Lord's Supper

**Why do we only partake on  
Sunday?**

**Approved apostolic  
example –  
Acts 20:6-7,  
I Cor. 16:2**

**(Jesus was raised on  
Sunday – Mark 16:9)**

**The Church was  
established on  
Sunday (Acts 2)**

# Preparing our minds for the Lord's Supper

Is it wrong to have a “second serving”?

Not a second serving, it is a second offering; to those who did not have the opportunity the first time

They are added to our communion – I Cor. 10:16-17

# Preparing our minds for the Lord's Supper

**Can just anyone partake, or only certain people?**

**It only has meaning for Christians –  
I Cor. 10:16-17**

**While a non-Christian cannot partake in a worthy manner (I Cor. 11), we should not prevent them from this, but rather use the opportunity to teach.**

# Preparing our minds for the Lord's Supper

The Lord's Supper is the focal point of our service, not the sermon! – Acts 20:6-7

If I cannot partake  
properly, I am lost!  
I Cor. 11:27

# Preparing our minds for the Lord's Supper

As I partake, what should be  
in my mind?

What it represents:

His death (body and blood) – Mt.  
26:57-68, 27:24-31, 35-54

Jesus as our Passover – I Cor. 5:7

Our complete devotion to Him. Examination  
is necessary – I Cor. 11:27-32; Isa. 53
