Moses' Example of Faith

- **Heb. 11:23** – Learned from the faithful influences around him
 - Moses' parents hid Moses, not afraid of the command of Pharaoh
 - It is clear by Moses' knowledge and faith in Jehovah that he was influenced by his parents, or at least the Hebrews
 - We can look to others as examples in life
 - Christian character in adversity, etc

Moses' Example of Faith

- **Heb. 11:24-26** – Cared more about the spiritual than the physical
 - Moses chose God over the riches of Egypt
 - He cared to suffer reproach
 - We must decide what is most important to us, set it as our priority and stick to it
 - We must be prepared to make sacrifices in our efforts to obey God

Moses' Example of Faith

- **Heb. 11:27** – Did not fear man
 - When Moses left Egypt, he was running for his life; when he returned, he was bringing the hope of life for the Israelites
 - Moses did what God commanded despite what had happened in Egypt
 - **Matt. 10:28** – Fear God, not man
 - We cannot allow how people might react sway us from teaching, setting an example

Moses' Example of Faith

- **Heb. 11:28** – Believed, feared, God's power
 - Moses knew that what God said He would do, He had the power to do it
 - Moses acted on this faith by operating on the promise that God would do as He said He would
 - Do we operate on the same basis?
